This has been an exciting month of outreach to college students at Iowa State University! God has been moving in incredible ways! Thank you so much for your support of this ministry! First, let me tell you a little about myself. Although I didn't grow up going to church, as a junior in high school I began attending a Bible study that met once a week before school. When I saw how seriously the people there took the Bible and a relationship with God, I wanted to learn more and I started reading the Bible on my own. One night during the spring of that year, as I was reading my Bible I finally understood why Jesus died for my sins, and I made him the Lord and Savior of my life!

I went to college at Iowa State University about a year and a half later. Then I got involved with a local church and campus ministry affiliated with Great Commission Ministries. The people I met there helped me to understand how much the world needs to hear about Jesus. Over the course of my college years, I had many opportunities to share my faith with other young women and help them in turn learn to do the same.

As I thought about life after college, I could imagine nothing more rewarding than continuing to build into the lives of college students. Over five thousand new students come to the Iowa State Campus every year, and the ideas they learn while in college will shape how they live the rest of their lives. I am excited to have the opportunity to work full-time to influence these students for Christ. The organization that makes it possible for me to do this is Great Commission Ministries (GCM).
