The Great Adventure was a mix of challenging teachings, dynamic worship, and times of building friendships and community.

One talk focused on God's grace and the truths He has for us in the Word, specifically in Ephesians 1:4-8. The speaker revealed 10 truths about ourselves in this passage. We were all challenged to believe these truths and live them out each day.

On Saturday afternoon, we had an H2O olympics, which was a competition between the three H2O churches that were in attendance at the retreat: Bowling Green, Kent State, and OSU. We played six different games, all of which forced us to work together on our team of 10 to do
