"If I Should Die" Form

In the unlikely event of your death during your international ministry term, Reliant will be required to furnish an official letter of instruction to the host country's government as to what to do with your remains. Without an official letter, the host government may not release your remains for transport back to your home country. Therefore, it is imperative that this form be filled out completely. You will also need to have this form notarized by an official notary public.

Instructions:

NOTARY STAMP:

- 1. Sign this form in the presence of an official notary public, either in person or through an online service.
- 2. Give a copy (physical or digital) to the Executor of Estate.
- 3. Email a digital copy to international@reliant.org
- 4. Take a copy with you on your international ministry assignment and keep it in a safe place. Also, notify your local team leader or another member of your ministry team as to its specific location.
